

ONYX CURBSIDE

The quality of material is a fundamental element in recycling. To make material processing efficient and cost effective. PLEASE observe the following instructions.

Curbside Recycling Program

CANS

Food and Beverage cans ONLY.
Aluminum, bimetal, and tin cans ONLY,
no other metal containers are acceptable.
Please rinse all cans.
Cans may be crushed.
Cans - Glass - Plastics can be mixed,
but must be separated from newsprint.

NEWSPAPER

Newspaper and newspaper advertisement
are acceptable. They need to be placed in
paper grocery sacks. Also accepted are
magazines, cereal boxes, pop and beer
containers.

GLASS CONTAINERS

ONLY food and beverage bottles and jars are
acceptable.
Clear, brown, and green glass are all
acceptable.
Please rinse all bottles and jars.
Please THROW AWAY ALL CAPS.
Labels and rings can be left on.

CLEAR AND COLORED PLASTIC CONTAINERS

An example of acceptable plastics:

- *One gallon milk bottles
- *One gallon water bottles
- *One, two and three liter pop bottles
- *Detergent & fabric softener bottles
- *Margarine containers.

Please rinse all bottles.
Please throw away caps.

Please rinse and flatten bottles.

Garbage Preparation Guidelines

1. All trash should be at the curb the evening before your pick-up day.
2. All trash must be placed in a container or bag not larger than 30 gallons in capacity.
3. Bulky items such as furniture and construction debris, are NOT included with rural pick-up. Call Onyx to arrange for a pick-up (815) 874-8431.
4. Large dumpsters are available for large clean-up or remodeling projects.
5. Hot ashes are not to be placed in the garbage containers.
6. Contact Onyx Disposal at (815) 874-8431 with any questions you may have regarding garbage pick-up

NOTE:

All plastic food bottles and containers have a number stamped on the bottom. ANY NUMBER - 1 THROUGH 7 - will be accepted.
PLEASE NO OIL CONTAINERS.

Any non-recyclable material will be left at your curb!

CURBSIDE RECYCLING WILL BE ONE SORT.
THIS WILL INCLUDE ALL RECYCLABLES TO BE
COMBINED TOGETHER, EXCEPT NEWSPAPER
SHOULD BE PLACED IN PAPER BAGS OR
BUNDLED.
