

MORING RURAL DISPOSAL FOR AREAS OTHER THAN BYRON AND STILLMAN VALLEY

GARBAGE PREPARATION GUIDELINES

*CURBSIDE RECYCLING IS NOT AVAILABLE

1. Up to 5 bags or containers not exceeding 33 gallons in capacity or 30 lbs in weight, which are placed at the curb on your pick-up day will be collected.
2. All trash and recyclables should be placed at the curb the evening before your pick-up day.
3. All trash must be in covered containers or bags and not exceeding 33 gallons in capacity. No loose, uncontained items will be picked-up.
4. Major Appliances (White Goods) : Stoves, dishwashers, washers, dryers, refrigerators, freezers, water heaters, water softeners and air conditioners are all considered major appliances and Byron residents can contact Moring Disposal for pricing information and to make arrangements for removal of these items.
5. Bulky Waste: Household items will be collected on your pick-up day. Bulky items include couches, chairs, tables, dressers, mattresses, bikes, large toys, etc. Rural residents can contact Moring Disposal for pricing information and to make arrangements for removal of these items.
6. **Bulky Waste Does Not Include Construction, Demolition or Remodeling Waste.** To have waste, such as old fencing, doors, windows, drywall, wood scraps from remodeling, carpeting, block, brick, rock, sand, dirt, landscape timbers, old car parts, etc., residents can contact Moring Disposal for pricing and to arrange for removal of these items.
7. **Household Hazardous Waste** is not acceptable with weekly curbside collection. Watch for county Household Hazardous Waste Collection programs (click on future Events to see if one is being planned). Latex paint can be dried and put out with your regular garbage.
8. Large dumpsters are available for large clean-up or remodeling projects. Contact Moring to order temporary containers.
