

City of Oregon Curbside Refuse and Recycling Outline

Requirements for items to be recycled:

Metal: Tin and aluminum cans only
Make sure all cans are empty and clean
Place lids inside of cans
Labels do **NOT** have to be removed

Glass: Jars and bottles only
Make sure containers are empty and clean, remove lids and throw in garbage
Labels do **NOT** have to be removed

Plastic: Containers with #1 through #7 Only
Make sure containers are empty and clean, remove lids
Labels do have to be removed

Paper: Newsprint
All newsprint is acceptable
Stack neatly in your recycling bin or a paper grocery bag

GENERAL RECYCLING INFORMATION

1. RECYCLABLES SHOULD BE PLACED AT THE CURB THE EVENING BEFORE PICK-UP DAY.
2. NEWSPRINT CAN BE STACKED ON THE BOTTOM OF THE BIN WITH ALL OTHER MATERIALS COMMINGLED ON TOP.
3. IN THE EVENT THAT YOU HAVE MORE RECYCLABLES THAN YOUR BIN WILL HOLD, SIMPLY PLACE EXCESS ITEMS IN A SEPARATE BAG OR CONTAINER NEXT TO YOUR BIN.
4. ALL RESIDENCES MUST HAVE A RECYCLING BIN AT THE CURB TO INDICATE THAT YOU HAVE RECYCLABLES TO BE PICKED UP.
5. PLASTIC BAGS ARE UNACCEPTABLE FOR SEPARATION OF RECYCLABLES, PAPER GROCERY BAGS ONLY.
6. REPLACEMENTS FOR LOST, STOLEN OR BROKEN BINS CAN BE OBTAINED AT THE CITY HALL.

Garbage preparation guidelines:

- ◇ All trash and recyclables must be at the curb by 6:00 A.M..
- ◇ All trash must be placed in a container or bag not larger than 33 gallons in capacity.
- ◇ Containers or bags should not exceed a weight of 30 lbs.
- ◇ Loose, uncontained items should be placed in a bag or container for pick-up.
- ◇ Bulky items, such as furniture, are included in the program at no additional cost.
- ◇ Construction debris is not acceptable, contact Moring Disposal* to make special arrangements.
- ◇ Large dumpsters are available for major clean-up or remodeling projects. Call Moring Disposal* to order temporary containers.
- ◇ Household hazardous waste is not acceptable. Residents should watch for county sponsored programs which are held periodically.
- ◇ Large dumpsters are available for major clean-up or remodeling projects.
- ◇ Yard waste services are provided every two weeks from April through November. Residents can place yard waste in biodegradable bags or designate refuse containers by placing a large "X" on the side. Brush up to 1" in diameter may be placed curbside but must be in bundles not exceeding 4' long and 1' in diameter.
