

Village of Stillman Valley Curbside Refuse and Recycling Program Outline

RECYCLABLE ITEM PREPARATION REQUIREMENTS

Metal Products

Tin and aluminum cans, formed metal containers, i.e.: cake, pie, pizza pans, foil products, etc. Rinse all items completely free of food. Place lids inside of cans, labels do not have to be removed.

Glass Products

Glass jars and bottles only: Rinse and remove lids. Labels do not have to be removed

Plastic Products

Plastic jugs and bottles: Containers with the numbers 1 through 7 on the bottom (except Styrofoam products). Rinse, remove lids and discard them in trash. Labels do not have to be removed. Containers should be free of any liquids.

Paper Products

Newsprint, magazines, chipboard, junk mail, corrugated containers, phone books. All paper items should be bundled or stacked neatly in your recycling bin or a paper grocery bag.

General Recycling Information

1. Recyclables should be placed at the curb the evening before your pick-up day.
2. Loose paper and plastic items should be stacked on the bottom of the bin with all other materials separated in paper grocery bags on top to avoid blowing on windy days.
3. In the event that you have more recyclables than your bin will hold, simply place excess items in a separate bag or container next to your bin.
4. All residences must have their recycling bin at the curb to indicate that you have recyclables to be picked up.
5. Plastic grocery bags are unacceptable for separation of recyclables.
6. Replacements for lost, stolen or broken bins can be obtained at the city hall.

Garbage Preparation Guidelines

1. All trash should be at the curb the evening before your pick-up day.
2. All trash must be placed in a container or bag not larger than 30 gallons in capacity.
3. Containers or bags must not exceed a weight of 30 lbs.
4. Each residence is allowed one (1) thirty (30) gallon bag or barrel of trash each week, along with unlimited recycling collection. Residents can purchase stickers for additional bags of trash at Castelli's Royal Blue Store at 130 N. Walnut St.
5. Loose, uncontained items will not be picked up.
6. Bulky items such as furniture, construction debris, appliances, and household hazardous waste are not included with normal pick up. Residents requiring removal of appliances or construction debris should contact Moring Disposal to make special arrangements. Residents with household hazardous waste should look for county sponsored programs which are held periodically.
7. Large dumpsters are available for large clean-up or remodeling projects.
